- 1. Balboa Park- the nation's largest urban cultural park. Home to 15 major museums, renowned performing arts venues, beautiful gardens and the San Diego Zoo. - 2. Cabrillo National Monument- Namesake of a 16th-century explorer of San Diego Bay, the Cabrillo Monument, run by the National Park Service, offers spectacular views, a historic lighthouse, whale watching overlook and a visitors' center with a museum. End of Catalina Boulevard.
- 3. Dog Beach- is a dog run area where dogs are permitted without a leash at all hours of the day. Dog owners are responsible for control and clean-up of their dogs. Standard dog laws apply on other portions of the beach and are strictly enforced. West Point Loma Blvd. at Voltaire St.
- Dusty Rhodes Dog Park- friendly expanse offering picnic, playground, soccer and lacrosse fields. Sunset Cliffs Boulevard.
- **5. Famosa Slough-** is a 30-acre urban wetland in San Diego, at the intersection of West Point Loma and Famosa boulevards.
